The Canada Winter Games are a multi-sport event held every four years with the inception of Ringette in 1991 in Charlottetown, PEI. Since then, Ringette Saskatchewan has provided many athletes and team staff with this unforgettable experience. Past SaskFirst Ringette Teams have finished strong at all Games, with the 1999 Team securing a bronze medal, the first and only Games medal for Saskatchewan Ringette. The 2019 program is looking to improve upon this success and leave Red Deer with a medal.

The next Canada Winter Games will be held in February 2019 in Red Deer, Alberta. As an eligible competitor by age, this letter is to offer you the unique opportunity to be part of the 2019 SaskFirst program. This invitation is being extended to all athletes born 1999 and later.

This "AAA" program will start this April 2017 when the first talent identification camp will be held in Pilot Butte. Talent identification camps will continue to be held until the final roster is selected by June 30, 2018. The goal of this program is long-term athlete development including; position specific skill development, Ringette IQ, nutritional expertise, mental strength and off-ice physical fitness.

This program will require a full commitment from all participants. On and off-ice training and competition will increase as we approach the 2018-2019 season. This will be a very challenging program that will require commitment to the program, discipline to your body and passion for this sport. Eighteen athletes will be rewarded with the opportunity to participate

at the 2019 Canada Winter Games. This program is partially funded through Ringette Saskatchewan and Sask Lotteries. The remaining cost will come from athlete fees and fundraising efforts. The cost for the first 2 identification camps is \$300 an athlete.
