MAP Distribution

After clinic facilitator/instructor expenses have been deducted from MAP, the remaining monies will be split into two pools; Base funding and Bonus funding.

- 50% Base funding: Awarded to each of the 4 local associations based on the number of registered Bunny to Tween athletes they have as of December 31st.
- 50% Bonus funding: Divided into four evaluation components:
 - √ 25% divided amongst local associations that increase their player registrations from the previous season, Bunny to Tween
 - ✓ 25% divided amongst local associations based on an objective evaluation of their participation in RAS athlete programs; Bunny Jamboree, Novice Jam, Petite Skill Development sessions, Petite Par-Tay, Provincial Championships.
 - √ 25% divided amongst associations who meet a 90% or higher compliance ratio of registered team staff meeting the mandatory certification requirements
 - ✓ 25% divided amongst local associations whose representation at the RAS AGM workshops and business meeting is equal to, or greater than, their voting entitlement.

*Note: Undispersed funds will be added back to the base funding and distributed accordingly.

Base funding will be announced to local associations by January 31st.

Bonus funding will be announced to local associations by April 30th.

Local associations will be required to submit a MAP follow-up report form and receipts for eligible expenses, equivalent to, or exceeding their total eligible amount by May 15th.

MAP funding will be issued to local associations by May 31st.

*Note: Eligible expenditures for MAP funding include all RAS sanctioned promotional activities or events, RAS clinic expenses, and any RAS sanctioned athlete development activities.
