RE: Return to Play Update

Earlier this week we were made aware that the Public Health Order originally set on December 17<sup>th</sup>, 2020 has been extended until January 29<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

On Wednesday January 13<sup>th</sup> Sask Sport held a virtual meeting with all provincial sport organizations and Ken Dueck from the Business Response Team. During this meeting Ken informed us there would be no consideration of return to play (games) for at least four weeks and that a return to game play is unlikely to happen before the end of March.

Regrettably, this information is not the news we were hoping for, but it allows our Associations to plan for the next couple of months knowing that game play is unlikely to be allowed.

RAS is currently reviewing our future plans and intend to offer some virtual training and competitions for our athletes, information will be released in the coming weeks.

Please remember that the current COVID environment is always evolving and we will continue to stay in communication with the Business Response Team and provide updates as they come available.
