Awards

MVP Player of the game

Each coach and bench staff must pick an individual from the opposite team that you felt was the most outstanding player of each game your team played. Immediately following all round robin games, a manager or member of the coaching staff is required to fill out a ballot at the registration desk with your MVP of the game pick. The votes will be tallied at the end of the round robin games and we will award an individual in each division the MVP of the tournament award at their final game of the weekend.

Most Sportsmanlike Team

The definition of a sportsmanlike individual/team is someone that exhibits qualities that are fair, in good temper, and have courtesy

Ringette Saskatchewan will be awarding a team that shows these qualities during this weekend. We ask coaches, parents, managers, officials, and volunteers to observe other teams that exhibit sportsmanlike quality on and off the ice. If you see a team or individuals on a team exhibiting these please come to the registration table and nominate them.
