RE: Return to Ringette

We hope you and your family are healthy and remain safe. We want to thank you for the good habits that you have been doing to control the spread of COVID-19.

Effective July 15th, 2020, Ringette Saskatchewan's Board of Directors lifted the suspension imposed on March 19th, 2020, that stopped all sanctioned ringette activity in our province.

There are many questions about the return to ringette now that modified activities are being allowed. Ringette Saskatchewan has made a comprehensive plan that aims to provide the best possible conditions for a safe, healthy, and enjoyable return for all participants. These guidelines offer a series of guiding principles in risk management, hygiene, and return to activity/competition. It is essential that everyone understands the decisions regarding the timing and protocol for resumption of ringette activity in this document are adhering to the Federal, Provincial, and Local Public Health Authorities.

Furthermore, Ringette Saskatchewan is following Ringette Canada's Return to Ringette progressions timeline along with all other provincial ringette organizations. The progressions are in place to inform best practices and alignment for ringette in Canada. Saskatchewan's gradual return to ringette will allow for ringette activities to restart in accordance with the Provincial Health Authorities Guidelines. On July 6th, 2020, the Saskatchewan Re-Open plan allowed for indoor sports and activities to resume, which would put Saskatchewan in progression 3 of Ringette Canada's Return to Ringette progression timelines.
